

SCRIP & KROGER FUNDRAISING FOR 2012 MARCHING BAND CAMP

The Dublin Music Boosters is again offering two fundraising programs to help defray the **2012** marching band camp fees: Kroger fundraising and Scrip fundraising.

Here are the guidelines:

- 75% of all monies earned through both Scrip and Kroger will go into your individual student's account; 25% will go to the DMB general fund.
- You can only raise up to the amount of your student's band camp fees (amount set by the directors) minus your band camp deposit (again, amount set by the directors).
- If you raise over that amount, the balance will not be applied to any other band fees or refunded to you. You cannot transfer that overage to another student, unless the other student is a member of your same household. Funds raised over the amount of band camp fees will go to the DMB general fund.
- If you participate in any fundraising, do not pay the entire amount of your band camp when you receive your band camp information packet in Spring 2012 and are asked to pay your band camp deposit.
- There will be absolutely no refunds.
- If you wish, you can participate in the program and designate all your earnings to the DMB general fund or a scholarship fund designated to your school.
- Family and friends can participate for a particular band student. However, they cannot transfer to another student once the original student's band camp fee total has been reached (unless the other student is a member of the same household).
- You **MUST** register your Kroger Plus card on the Kroger website www.krogercommunityrewards.com **YEARLY**. If you fail to register your card **yearly**, Kroger will not have you on their report and we will not be able to award you any funds. See the Kroger Instruction sheet for more details.
- It is important to sign up with Kroger as soon as possible, as you don't earn funds until you are registered with them.
- It is your responsibility to inform Raye Lynne Gerber (raye.lynne.gerber@att.net) that you are participating in the current 2012 Kroger fundraising. **Prior participation does not count!** If she does not get an email, you will not be awarded any funds. The last day to request funds is April 30, 2012.
- Raye Lynne will send you a confirmation email once you email her your information. If you do not receive her email within 2 weeks, please send a follow-up email.
- Kroger Community Rewards 2012 Band Camp Fundraiser and Scrip 2012 Band Camp Fundraiser will end April 30, 2012.
- If your designated student decides to not participate in marching band, all accumulated funds will go into the DMB general fund.

Detailed descriptions on how to participate in the Scrip fundraiser and in the Kroger fundraiser are given in separate documents.
